The Demo Air Net attaches quickly and easily to your existing box or circular fan. The fan creates a vortex, a whirling or circular motion that forms a vacuum, drawing debris into the center of the fan and into the net. The Demo Air Net filters the air moving outward keeping the debris and particles in the net. In just seconds you can see the net removing and trapping the airborne pollutants from your jobsite. An 18-inch fan will create a vortex approximately twice its size— well beyond the area in front of the fan. The vortex works best when the fan and net are placed in a doorway or a location that will not obstruct the pull.

Putting up plastic is a hassle and a waste of money in labor and materials. Also, it doesn't even contain all of the airborne pollutants. The reusable Demo Air Net is fast and easy to use. Once you have finished using the net, just throw it into your wash machine using the gentle cycle and let air-dry. It can be used over and over again.
